Our climate is suitable to Mediterranean grape varieties such as Pinot Grigio and Montepulciano, which are fast becoming more popular with consumers, and our region is producing exceptional examples of them."

The judging for the wine show was held from Monday 2nd September through to late Wednesday 4th September, where 18 judges worked tirelessly tasting and scoring over 800 wine entries. The judging panels, headed up by Gabrielle Poy, had a great mix of winemakers, sommeliers, and buyers, offering a diverse mix of people from across Australia and locally.
